## Tree Removal

Ranging from small domestic tree removal to commercial felling, our team utilise the latest techniques to remove trees safely...

Reasons for removal could include:

- -Declining health of the tree
- -Potential risk to people or property
- -Ensuring the health of surroudning flora

We try to avoid complete removal where possible, using our expertise to advise where trees can be saved and only removing as a last resort.

Once removed, we also provide Stump Grinding Services to take the remaining tree stump below ground level.

## **Protected Trees**

We will always check the protection status of all trees we work on.

If a tree has a Protection Order or falls within a conservation area, we are more than happy to take on the planning application process on your behalf.



# Stump Grinding

We use the latest in Stump Grinding machinery and techniques to remove unwanted tree stumps.

Stumps may need removing after a tree has died, to prevent parasites & fungus spreading, or to prevent future regrowth.

## **How Does it Work?**

The process involves grinding the stump in to chippings which are left on site and provide an excellent planting medium for future garden projects.

After removing the tree we cut the remaining stem as low as possible.



Our machine reduces the remaining stump to chippings, which are left on site.



This fills the hole and provides and ideal planting medium for the next stage of landscaping.



Crown Reduction

Reduction of the overall size and shape of the tree



**Crown Thinning** 

Reduction of branch volume, reducing crown density to increase sunlight.



Crown Lifting

Removal of lower branches to raise the canopy



Formative Pruning

The pruning of young trees to encourage good form and structure

Removal of dead branches from the canopy



# Pollarding

The process of heavily reducing a tree to encourage manageable regrowth



## Limb Removal

Removal of dangerous, overhanging and encroaching limbs

We recommended pollarding - the process of removing all growth back to the main stems to encourage re-growth.




This is the best way to keep a healthy, mature tree that might be a bit too big at a manageable size.
